## Introduction To Outdoor Leader Skills

Who: Adults who are, or plan to be <u>Scoutmasters</u> or <u>Assistant Scoutmasters</u>; also <u>Cub Scout/Webelos</u> <u>leaders</u> who will be crossing over to a Scout troop in the next 6-12 months. Troop committee chairs are also invited to attend in order to better support their troop.

**NOTE:** This course is prerequisite for Wood Badge. If you plan to take Wood Badge in the next 12-18 months, you should give serious consideration to attending this session.

Participants should have completed Scoutmaster /Assistant Scoutmaster Leader Specific Training as a prerequisite to this training. BSA Health form parts A & B required upon check-in at the class site.

Introduction To Outdoor Leader Skills, informally known as "Outdoor Training" is the final component of training *required* for all Scoutmasters and Assistant Scoutmasters to be recognized as *Basic Trained*. As a participant, you will get hands-on training in the practical outdoor skills you need to lead Scouts in the out-of-doors. You will function as a Scout Troop, camping, eating, and learning in patrols. Instructors will help you learn how to set up camp, cook, work with woods tools, tie the essential Scout knots, first aid, campfire program planning, map and compass skills, hiking & packing techniques, nature identification, Leave No Trace, and much more. This training brings to life the pages of the Boy Scout Handbook to help you deliver the promise of Scouting to yourself and the youth you serve. It will increase your comfort level and give you the confidence as a trained, skilled leader. In addition this training affords you the opportunity to work with other Scouters both in your district and from all over the council, to make new friends, and to strengthen your support network of Scouters. You will make lasting friendships and will spend a weekend that will be one of the most fun and memorable experiences in your Scouting career. This training is limited to 40 participants, so get your registration in early to ensure you will be enrolled. Once 40 participants are registered, additional registrations will be placed on a waiting list.
