What are the financial costs of scouting with Pack 31?

The following fees are collected annually:

Additional costs:

- Cub Scout uniform-cost varies
- Den Handbook-\$24
- Outings and campouts-varies (we strive to keep outing costs as low as possible)

Fundraising

One point of the scout law is a scout is thrifty. We have multiple opportunities to fundraise your way through the program to help offset program costs.

Popcorn sales run through September and October. Camp discount cards are sold during January and February. We are able to maintain our pack without Pack dues because of the commission from our fundraiser sales. The proceeds pay for:

Pack 31 Events


Pack 31 plans a well rounded program of weekly den meetings during the school year as well as special events. We participate in many council events, as well as hold pack-only events:



Shoot-o-ree-An event held to get scouts an opportunity to shoot sling-shots, bow and arrow, and BB guns and earn their Shooting Sports award. Typically occurs in September.



Gold Rush—An annual York District event typically held in October. Scouts participate in field games. Each pack designs and runs a game. Scout families have the option to camp out with the pack the night before. **Raingutter Regatta**—An annual pack event. Scouts assemble and decorate a boat kit for racing in a rain gutter filled with water, using their own "wind power" to compete.



Pinewood Derby—An annual pack event and scout favorite! Scouts build and decorate a car built from a block of pinewood. Cars are raced on a gravity powered ramp. The fastest Pack 31 cars then compete against other packs in a district race.



Scouting for Food—An annual nationwide service event. Scouts distribute bags and collect food for those in need. Our pack donates the collected food to the food bank at Hope of Rock Hill. Blue & Gold Banquet—This is the pack party celebrating the birthday of the Boy Scouts of America! Each banquet has a theme with food, awards, and games!



Spring Campout—Each spring, Pack 31 holds a local campout to give scouts a chance to get in the great outdoors. This event typically occurs in the spring when the weather is warming up!
