IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- Packs should bring one game per every ten participants. Games should be SAFE. Exercise caution and good judgement when creating games.
- Packs will provide 1 bag of candy for every ten participants, and will bring two buckets for each game (one to haul gold and one to collect gold to return to the mining field). Boys may want to bring bags for their loot.
- Packs should come ready to cook 1 Dutch oven cobbler per each 15 participants for the contest.
- There should be at least 2 leaders per game. Please ensure all scouts are able to participate.
- Each Cub should bring "gold" (3 gold painted rocks per participant). Gold Nuggets should be about the size of an inch around.
- Packs or Families are responsible for their own food and gear.
- All cubs will receive a patch; additional patches may be purchased for \$3 each.
- Each Pack should come prepared to perform 1 leader/adult ski and two Cub Scout skits. Skits must be submitted by 5 PM Saturday to be eligible to be performed.
